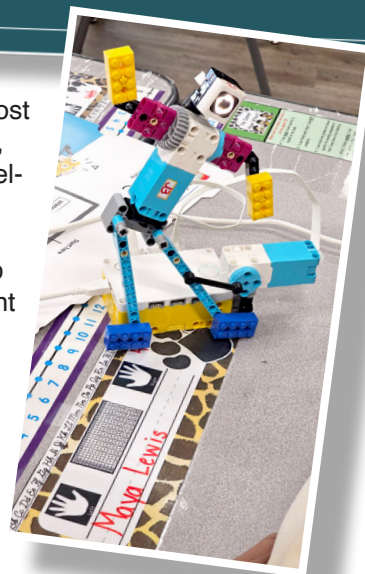
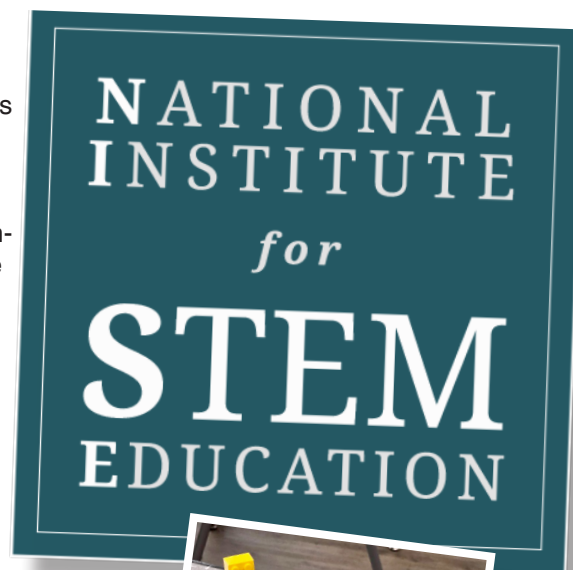

FHJ Receives National STEM Certification

F. H. Jenkins Preparatory School is proud to announce its certification as a National Institute for Stem Education (NISE) STEM campus. FHJ Prep was awarded the National Certificate for STEM Excellence (NCSE).

The National Certificate for STEM Excellence (NCSE) recognizes individual school campuses for their commitment to – and growth in – teachers' implementation of 21st Century and STEM strategies. Evolving from STEM professional development and curriculum created at Rice University, NISE STEM certificates integrate the most recent research and best practices in STEM, 21st Century Learning and professional development.

Over the course of 18 months, FHJ Prep worked alongside an NISE STEM leadership coach to craft a STEM action plan, implement professional development, and grow our overall STEM program. To date, FHJ Prep is the only NISE certified STEM campus in the state of Tennessee.

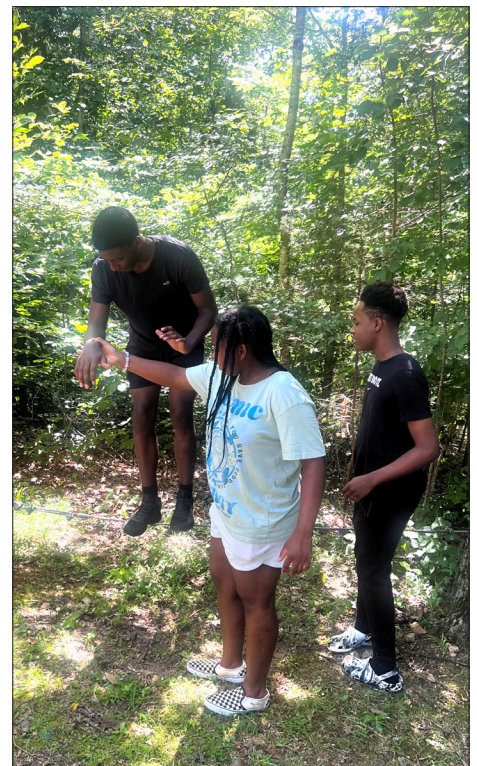
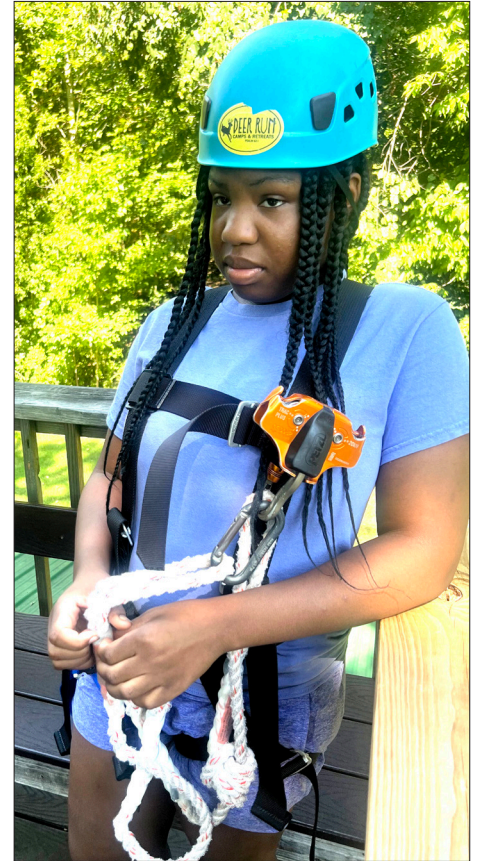


“Geared Up” for High School

Scholars traveled to Deer Run Camp to engage in various workshops and activities. The workshops were focused on helping our young people acclimate to their new high school experience, with topics inclusive of: time management, schedules, and building rapport with teachers. While at Deer Run scholars were able to swim, zip line, play laser tag and much more! We had a great time and scholars wanted to stay even longer.

At the beginning of the school year each scholar received a MacBook to use as a tool to assist them with their educational journey. Additionally, they were given the coveted FHJ backpack.
