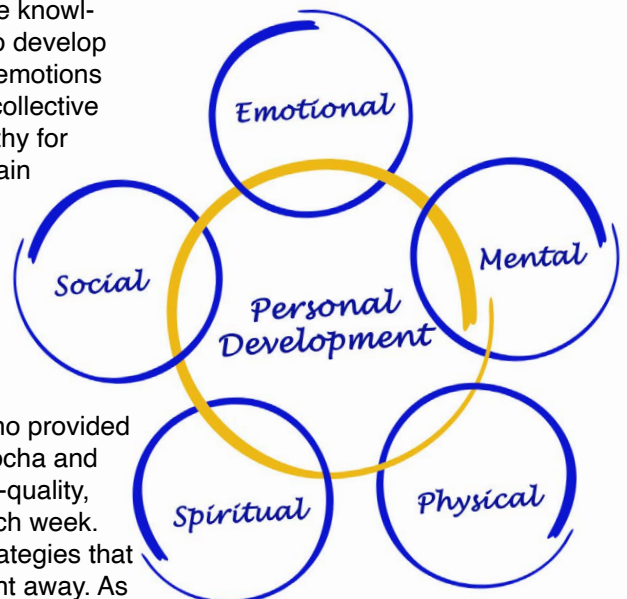

"SEL is the process through which all young people and adults acquire and apply the knowledge, skills, and attitudes to develop healthy identities, manage emotions and achieve personal and collective goals, feel and show empathy for others, establish and maintain supportive relationships, and make responsible and caring decisions (www.casel.org)."

a school, we seek to create an environment where scholars can holistically grow and develop. The addition of this partnership has been such a valuable asset to our program.



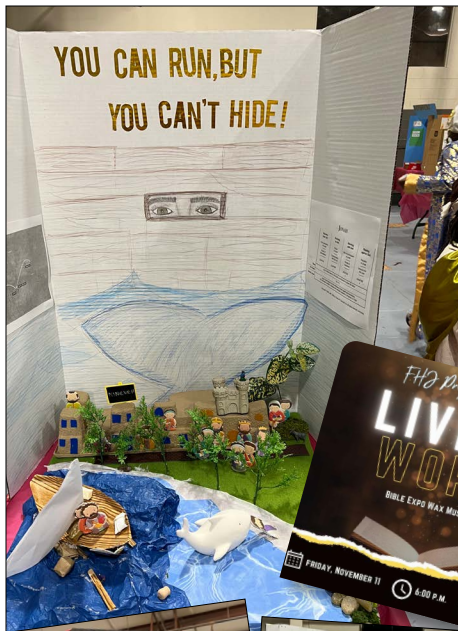

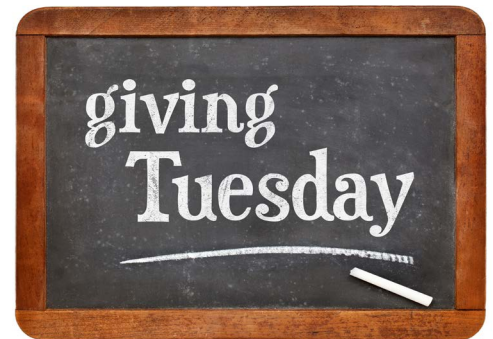


On Saturday night, December 17th the FHJ scholars put on a performance to remember. They shared the story of the coming of the Savior from the perspective of a host of stars.
